COVID PROTOCOL

- All Spectators MUST wear a face mask at all times inside the facility. This is an Alachua County rule
 and there are no exceptions. Masks may be removed when actively eating or drinking. Face shields
 are not acceptable.
- Please limit the number of spectators to 4 per athlete.
- Gymnasts must wear a mask except when on the competition floor. Masks must be worn in the awards area and may be removed when on the awards stand. Gymnasts are encouraged to wear their mask when not actively warming up or competing.
- After your child's session, please do not stay to watch other sessions. This allows other families to watch their child with appropriate social distancing.
- While in line to enter the building, at athlete registration, while paying door fees, at merchandising and concessions, please make sure to keep appropriate distance between you and the family ahead of you.

HOST HOTELS

AIRPORT

The closest airport is Gainesville Regional Airport (GNV). GNV is 13 miles from Alachua. The closest International Airports are in Tampa (TPA), Orlando (MCO) and Jacksonville (JAX).

REFUND POLICY

There are no entry fee refunds for athletes who withdraw from the competition (for any reason) after the State Entries have been received (February 12, 2021). The exception is petitioned athletes whose petitions are denied or do not receive medical clearance. Refunds for Petitioned Athletes who are not approved will be issued after the Region 8 Championships.

YOUR GPS DIRECTIONS MAY BE INCORRECT.

Following the directions on your GPS will put you in a field at the back of the Arena. Here is the best way to get to the Legacy Center parking lot.

- As you enter Alachua on 441 S from I-75, you will travel approximately 1 mile to NW 142nd Terrace.
- Turn RIGHT and follow 142nd Terr. to Peggy Road.
- Turn RIGHT on Peggy Road and the Legacy Center is approximately 1/2 mile on the right.
